

TOURIST VISA

Please Note:

- Application for Tourist Visa should be made at least one week before the planned date of travel.
- Maximum stay by a foreigner in India on a paper T-1 Visa or an e-T1 Visa or both in one calendar year shall be restricted to 180 days.
- Fees once paid will NOT be refunded.
- Consulate reserves the right to deny visa to the applicant without assigning any reason.

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A TOURIST VISA:

1. Original foreign passport valid for a minimum of 6 months and containing at least 3 blank pages.
2. A photocopy of the data page of the passport.
3. Two recent colour photographs (dimensions: 5X5 cm), with white background.
4. An Indian visa application form filled online: The application form for Regular/Paper visa can be found on the official website www.indianvisaonline.gov.in. Your signature on the form should match the signature on your passport.
5. Copy of return ticket(s) in the name of the applicant.
6. Proof of accommodation in India: Confirmation of hotel/stay booking or a letter from the person (host) the applicants intends to stay with stating that the applicant will be staying with them during their visit to India at their address (mention full address) along with valid ID proof of the host. In case these are not available, bank statement of last three months may be provided to prove availability of sufficient funds to undertake the visit and meet expenses in India.
7. If the applicant is a minor:
 - Photocopy of the French “livret de famille” (pages: father, mother, relevant child) or birth certificate
 - Photocopy of an ID proof of each parent
 - Authorization letter for a minor to travel signed by both parents
8. Copy of second passport, if the applicant is holding a non-French passport or having dual nationality.

- 9.** If you are holding a Travel document (Refugee Passport): Account statements for the last 3 months in your name.
- 10.** The above listed documents and rules are only indicative. Consulate may contact the applicants for any additional documents that may be required to process the application. Please use a valid and working email ID and telephone number.
- 11.** Visa services depend on several factors including residency of the applicant. The Consulate General of India in Reunion Island reserves the right to take the final decision on any application which will be binding on the applicant.
